Policy:

- 1.1. Great Rivers Behavioral Health Administrative Services Organization (Great Rivers BH-ASO) will create and maintain technical safeguards to restrict access to ePHI to those persons granted access rights consistent with their job responsibilities. These safeguards will include unique user identifications, emergency access procedures, automatic logoff, and encryption requirements.
- 1.2. Great Rivers BH-ASO's paper medical record files will be placed in limited access spaces, and access to those records will be controlled by medical records staff, or other appropriate, staff.
- 1.3. These controls will include a process for setting criteria for granting access and for modification of the criteria.
- 1.4. Great Rivers BH-ASO's systems will maintain an access authorization record to document and review the level of access granted to a user, program, or procedure. Great Rivers BH-ASO will assure that systems maintenance personnel have authorization for proper access. Great Rivers BH-ASO will not transmit PHI over the Internet (open network) without some form of encryption intended to limit access to information.
